The next regular Board Meeting will be at 8:00 AM on January 21, 2009.

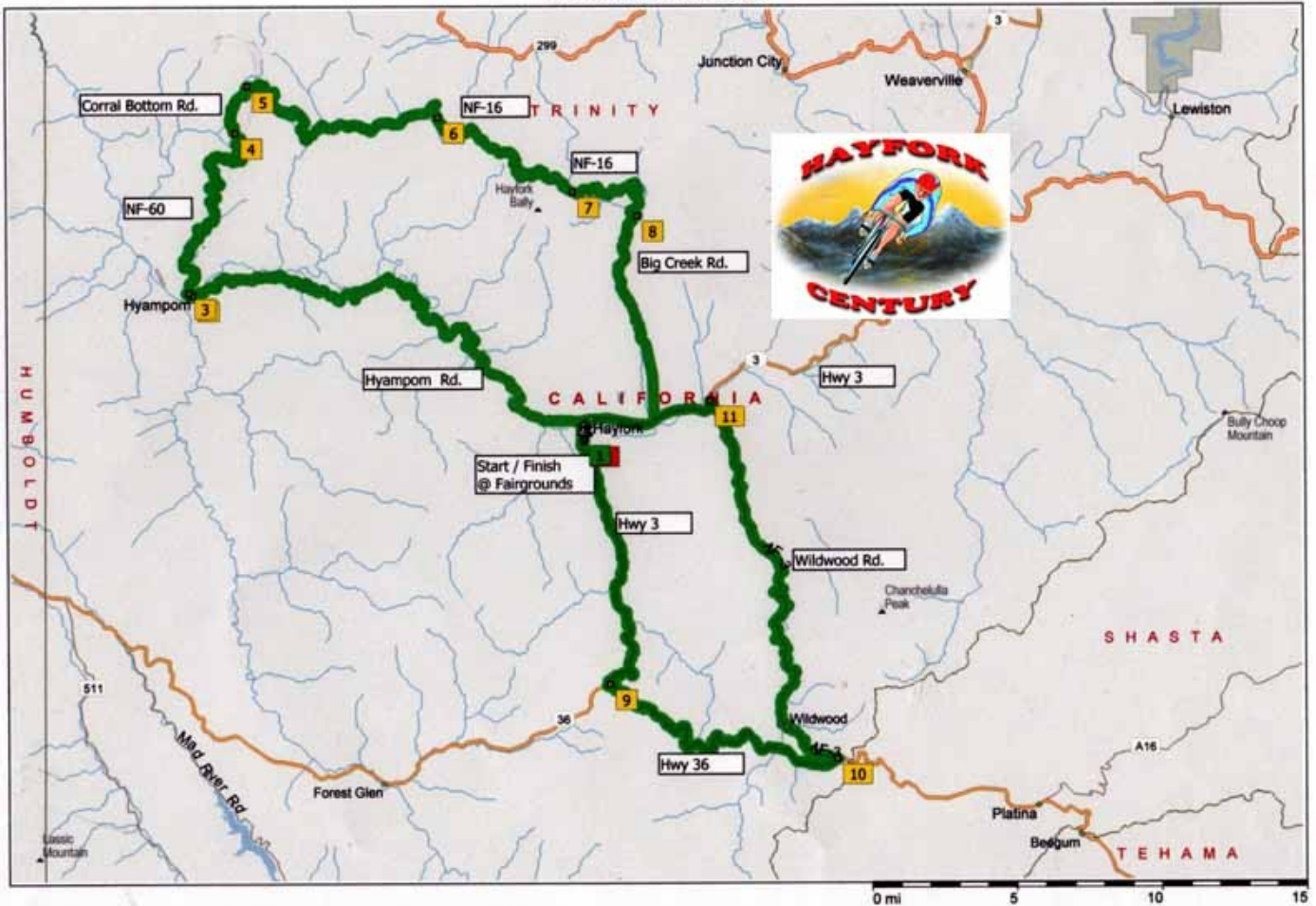
