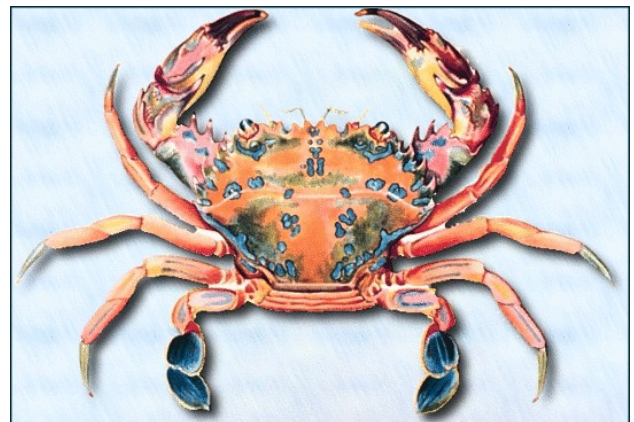
I had pictures of the lovely young ladies but I accidentally erased them while learning about my new camera.

The next regular Board Meeting will be at 8:00 AM on January 21, 2009.

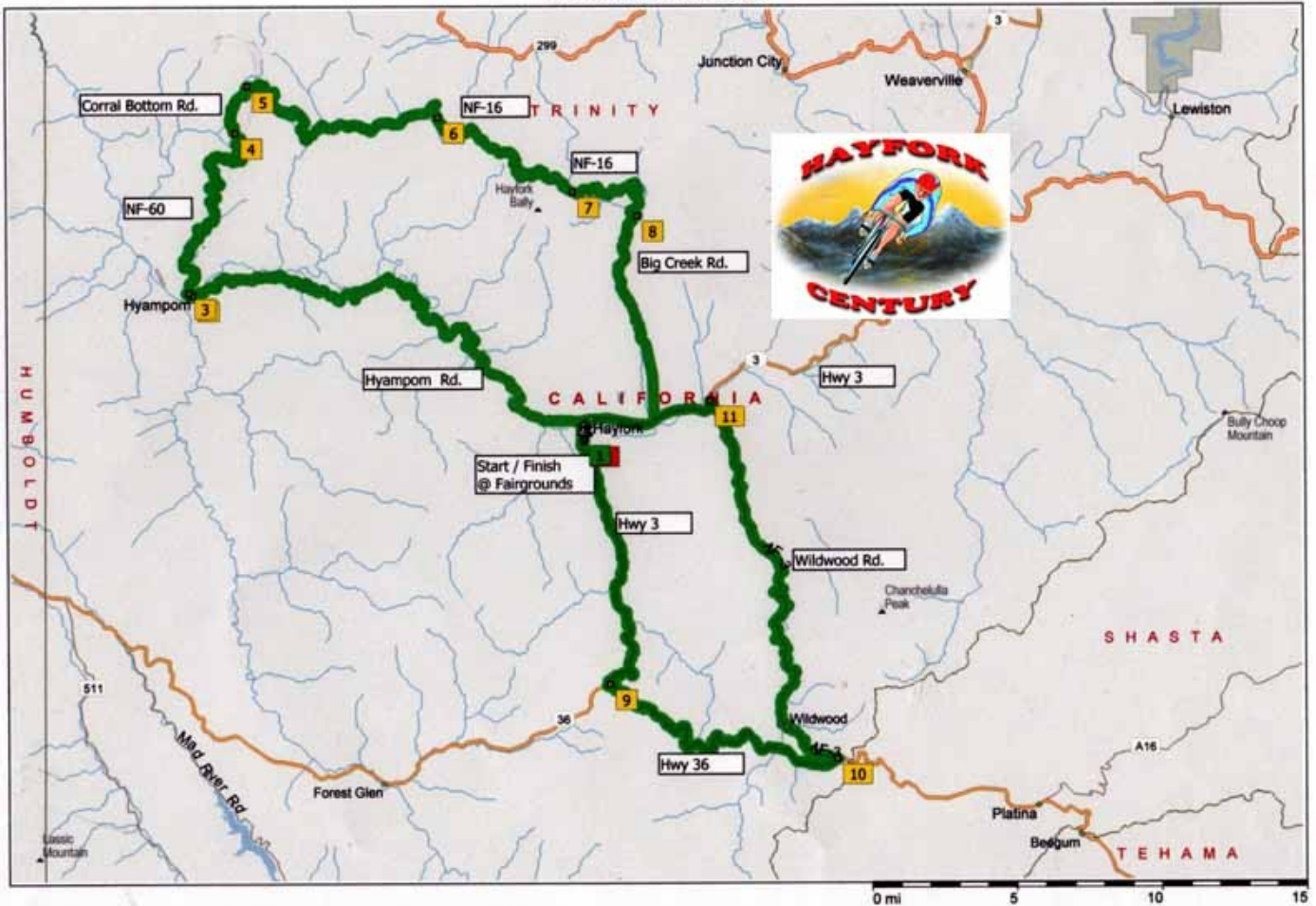
