At this time, the framework of the program is to present the materials in the form of a contest for producing posters.

The second program will concentrate on mentoring older students, and their involvement in community service. The goal being the growth of student's self esteem and the development of pride in ones community.

**Dori** has already seen great results with the few students that were mentored last year through working together with students on community projects, Rotary events and even their participation in our Rotary meetings.

**Karl** mentioned the fact that there appeared to be student interest at the High School in forming a Rotary Interact Club (14 to 18 year olds). However, he also stressed the fact that such a club would only be successful if there was a fully engaged teacher or counselor that could afford the time to give to the Club.
